Mill Creek once supported a healthy streamside forest, a vibrant Mono Lake delta, and abundant wildlife.

Mill Creek’s water is excessively diverted and the forest, delta and wildlife are suffering.

But it doesn’t have to be this way.

Now is the critical opportunity to protect Mill Creek.
